2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

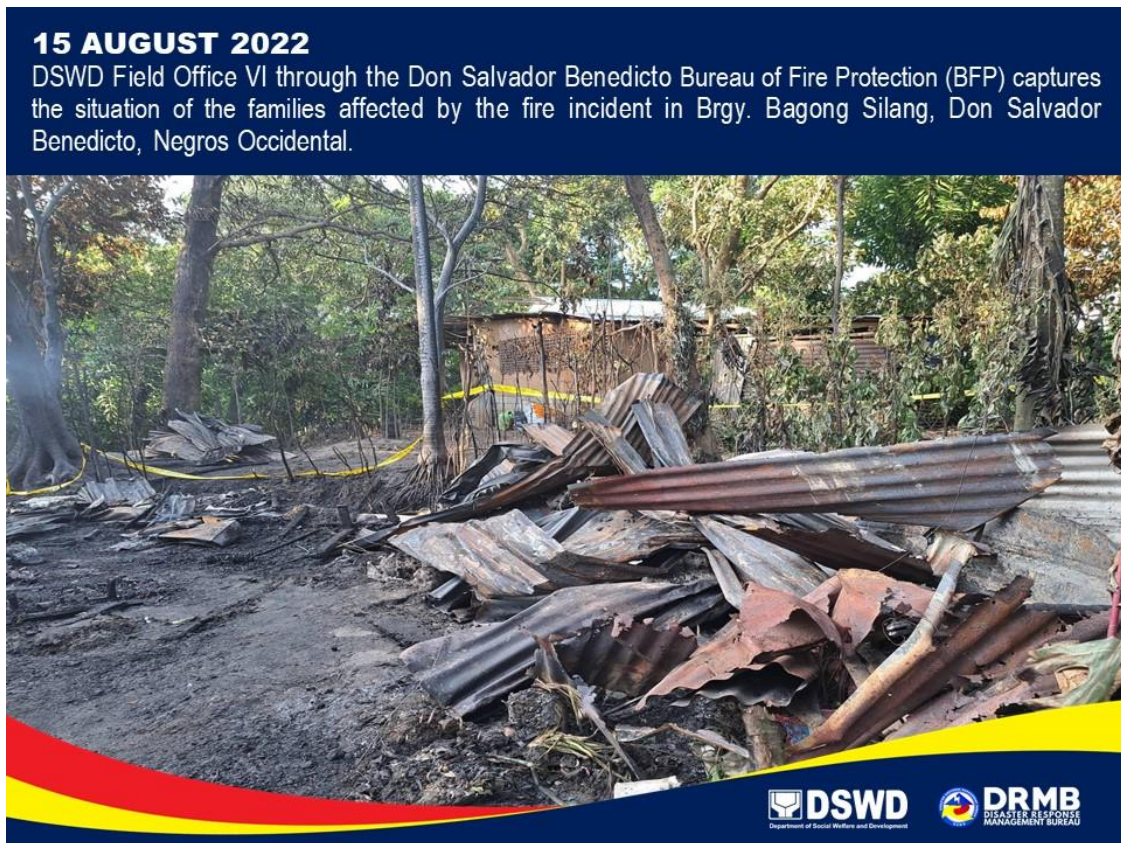
