

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Kabacan, North Cotabato

as of 10 August 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 08 August 2022, a flashflood incident occurred in Kabacan, North Cotabato caused by localized thunderstorms.

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 95,610 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 43,881 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 51,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

- 29,808 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱190.32 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
