

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Makilala, North Cotabato as of 17 August 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 August 2022, the Municipality of Makilala, North Cotabato experienced flashflood due to heavy rains caused by the Southwest Monsoon and localized thunderstorms.
