



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Sultan Kudarat

as of 23 August 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 August 2022, several municipalities in Sultan Kudarat experienced flashflood due to heavy rains caused by the Southwest Monsoon and localized thunderstorms.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,287 families** or **6,263 persons** are affected in **12 barangays** in **Sultan Kudarat** (see Table 1).

There are **447 families** or **2,235 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Sultan Kudarat** (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱765.50 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 74,701 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 23,972 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 50,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 22,799 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱142.31 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.

b. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
23 August 2022	 The Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices (MDRRMOs) of Bagumbayan, Isulan, and Esperanza conducted rescue operations and rapid damage assessments to the affected barangays of their respective municipalities. The Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (PDRRMO) of Sultan Kudarat aided in the rescue operations and assisted the displaced families in the evacuation centers. DSWD FO XII is currently processing the resource augmentation request from the Provincial Government of Sultan Kudarat. DSWD FO XII is continuously coordinating with MSWDOs and P/MDRRMOs of the affected LGUs for further updates and close monitoring of status of displaced and affected families.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO XII for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
