

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Valencia, Bukidnon

as of 12 August 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 05 August 2022, several barangays in Valencia, Bukidnon experienced flooding due to heavy rains caused by Southwest Monsoon or localized thunderstorms.
