

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Valencia, Bukidnon as of 13 August 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 August 2022, several barangays in Valencia, Bukidnon experienced flooding due to heavy rains caused by the Southwest Monsoon.

A total of **364 families** or **1,451 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Valencia, Bukidnon** (see Table 1).
