I. Situation Overview

On 17 July 2022, a flooding incident occurred in the municipality of Midsayap, North Cotabato due to localized thunderstorms.

- 97,778 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 46,049 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 51,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 32,290 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
