



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Pikit, North Cotabato

as of 16 August 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 August 2022, an armed conflict transpired between two (2) alleged rebel groups at Sitio Galigayan, Brgy. Macabual, Pikit, North Cotabato.

A total of 1,630 families or 5,916 persons are affected in one (1) barangay in Pikit, North Cotabato (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 1,075 families or 4,449 persons currently taking temporary shelter in six (6) evacuation centers in Pikit, North Cotabato. (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱765.5 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 98,160 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 46,431 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 51,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 24,046 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱162.42 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
