

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Pikit, North Cotabato

as of 16 August 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 10 August 2022, an armed conflict transpired between two (2) alleged rebel groups at Sitio Galigayan, Brgy. Macabual, Pikit, North Cotabato.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **1,075 families** or **4,449 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **six (6) evacuation centers** in **Pikit, North Cotabato**. (see Table 2).
