I. Situation Overview

On 30 August 2022 at around 10:59 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 198, Pasay City. It was declared fire out at 11:33 AM.

- ₱108.39 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.

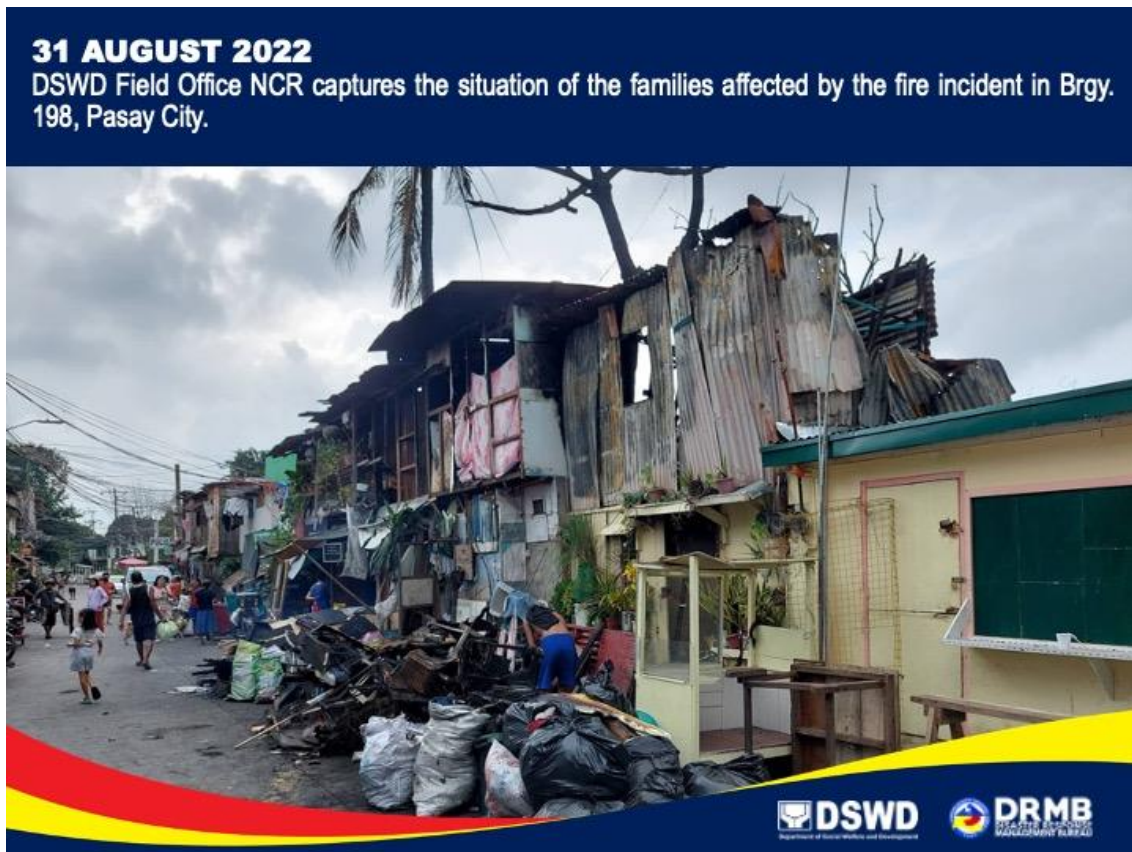
