I. Situation Overview

On 31 August 2022 at around 12:34 PM, a fire incident occurred in Sitio Lahing-Lahing 1, Brgy. Mabolo, Cebu City. It was declared fire out at 1:50 PM. The cause of fire is still under investigation.
