

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flashflood Incident in Makilala, North Cotabato

I. Situation Overview

On 14 August 2022, the Municipality of Makilala, North Cotabato experienced flashflood due to heavy rains caused by the Southwest Monsoon and localized thunderstorms.
