

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flashflood Incident in Sultan Kudarat

as of 10 September 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 18 August 2022, several municipalities in Sultan Kudarat experienced flashflood due to heavy rains caused by the Southwest Monsoon and localized thunderstorms.

A total of **1,337 families** or **6,513 persons** are affected in **12 barangays** in **Sultan Kudarat** (see Table 1).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **447 families** or **2,235 persons** sought temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Sultan Kudarat** (see Table 2).
