



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flashflood Incident in Sultan Kudarat

as of 10 September 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 August 2022, several municipalities in Sultan Kudarat experienced flashflood due to heavy rains caused by the Southwest Monsoon and localized thunderstorms.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 1,337 families or 6,513 persons are affected in 12 barangays in Sultan Kudarat (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **447 families** or **2,235 persons** sought temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Sultan Kudarat** (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱517.03 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 86,039 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 44,210 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 41,829 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 17,700 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱131.94 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.

08 September 2022	DSWD FO XII released a total of 1,337 FFPs as augmentation to the Provincial Government of Sultan Kudarat. The FFPs are scheduled for distribution to the affected families next week.

c. Other Activities

23 August 2022	 DSWD FO XII coordinated with Local Social Welfare and Development Offices (LSWDOs) and Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices (LDRRMOs) of the affected LGUs for further updates and close monitoring of status of affected and displaced families.





DATE	ACTIVITIES
	 The LDRRMOs of Bagumbayan, Isulan, and Esperanza in Sultan Kudarat conducted rescue operations and rapid damage assessments in the affected barangays. The Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (PDRRMO) of Sultan Kudarat aided in the rescue operations and assisted the displaced families in the evacuation centers.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO XII for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
