

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Collapsed Wall of Water Waste Lagoon in Nasugbu, Batangas

as of 03 August 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 July 2022 at around 9AM, the Waste Water Lagoon of ProGreen AgriCorp, Inc. (Andy Player Whisky - an alcohol distillery company) located in Sitio El Paso, Brgy. Lumbangan, Nasugbu, Batangas collapsed. Based on the initial investigation of the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO), a portion of the 100-meter retaining wall collapsed due to the heavy downpour experienced by the municipality the night prior to the incident.

DSWD FO CALABARZON provided financial assistance worth Php10,000.00 per family including the distribution of family food packs to the 88 affected families. DSWD FO CALABARZON deployed staff to provide Psychological First Aid to the affected families.
31 July 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> DSWD FO CALABARZON Regional Director Marcelo Nicomedes J. Castillo called an emergency meeting with the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) and Crisis Intervention Section (CIS) to immediately assess the situation and identify the necessary interventions. The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) of DSWD FO CALABARZON coordinated with the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC) of LGU Nasugbu, Batangas regarding the status of the ongoing clearing operations. The members of Batangas Quick Response Team (QRT) were advised to be on standby for deployment and conduct of Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA).
