

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Matina Aplaya, Talomo-B District, Davao City as of 13 August 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 03 August 2022 at around 9:30 PM, a fire incident broke out at Brgy. Matina Aplaya, Talomo-B District, Davao City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) of Davao City declared the incident fire out at 3:00 AM of 04 August 2022.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **170 families** or **850 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Davao City** (see Table 2).
