On 3 July 2022, at around 5:00 AM, a fire incident gutted down the “Ukay-Ukay” stalls at the 2nd floor of new building of the Polomolok Public Market.

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

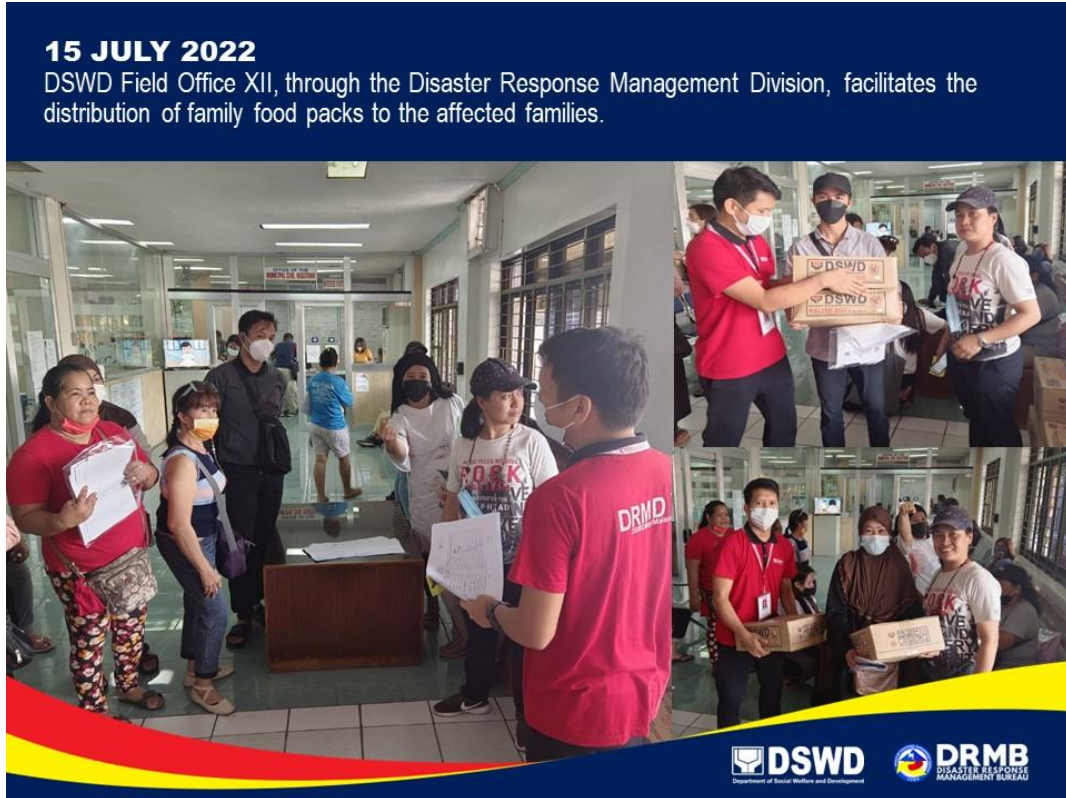
A total of **₱33,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Table 2).
