

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Matina Aplaya, Talomo-B District, Davao City

13 December 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 03 August 2022 at around 9:30 PM, a fire incident broke out in Brgy. Matina Aplaya, Talomo-B District, Davao City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) of Davao City declared the incident fire out on 04 August 2022 at 3 AM.

A total of **196 families** or **512 persons** were affected in **one (1) barangay** in **Davao City** (see Table 1).

There were a total of **170 families** or **425 persons** who took temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Davao City** (see Table 2).
