

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sambag, Jaro, Iloilo City

07 September 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 02 August 2022 at around 4:10 AM, a fire started at a mini store in Brgy. Sambag, Jaro, Iloilo City which has spread to nearby houses. Fire out was declared at 5:02 AM by the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP).
