

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incidents in Brgy. Calamba, Cebu City

### I. Situation Overview

On 29 July 2022 at around 2:29 AM, a fire incident occurred at V. Rama, Brgy. Calamba, Cebu City. Another fire incident occurred at Lucio Drive Brgy. Calamba, Cebu City at around 9:19 PM. The fire incidents were declared fire out at 2:35 AM and 9:19 PM respectively.
