

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident at Aries St., Brgy. Villamonte, Bacolod City as of 23 September 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 8 September 2022 at around 11:23 AM, a fire incident occurred at Aries St., Brgy. Villamonte, Bacolod City. The fire was declared out at 11:51 AM. The cause of fire was faulty electrical wiring in one of the gutted residential houses.
