

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Baybay City, Leyte

as of 21 September 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 September 2022 at around 3:25 PM, a fire incident occurred in Barangays Sto. Rosario and Poblacion Zone 8 in Baybay City, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 4:28 PM.

A total of **29 families** or **129 persons** are affected in **two (2) Barangays** in **Baybay City, Leyte** (see Table 1).
