

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 6, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

as of 06 September 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 31 August 2022 at around 4PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 6, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. It was declared fire out at around 4:30 PM. The cause of fire was due to overheating of a plugged appliance.
