## 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 73,706 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 42,977 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 30,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 17,278 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
