

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 662, Zone 71, Paco, Manila City

as of 15 September 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 September 2022 at around 9:38 AM, a fire incident occurred at Cristobal St., Brgy. 662, Zone 71, Paco, Manila City. The fire was declared out at 11 AM.

A total of **69 families** or **253 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 662, Zone 71, Paco, Manila City** (see Table 1).

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **69 families** or **253 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** of **Brgy. 662, Zone 71, Paco, Manila** (see Table 2).
