as of 21 September 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 September 2022 at around 2 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Anahaw, Labo, Camarines Norte. The initial investigation shows that the possible cause of fire is due to faulty wiring. Fire out was declared at 4 AM.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- ₱215.63 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO V warehouses.






b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)
