

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgys. Apolonio Samson and Balingasa, Quezon City

as of 08 September 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 08 September 2022 at around 9:58 AM, a fire incident occurred at Kaingin Rd., Brgy. Apolonio Samson and Don Manuel St., Brgy. Balingasa, Quezon City. The fire was declared under control at 1 PM.
