

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Capitol Site, Cebu City

as of 21 September 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 September 2022 at around 1:58 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Lower Panaghiusa, Brgy. Capitol Site, Cebu City. The fire was put under control at 2:24 PM and was declared fire out at 2:28 PM.

A total of **53 families** or **171 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Capitol Site, Cebu City** (see Table 1).

There are **53 families** or **171 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Gymnasium** of the affected barangay (see Table 2).

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 91,512 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 55,683 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 35,829 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 30,662 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱218.88 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.
