I. Situation Overview

On 27 August 2022 at around 10:18 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Poblacion Zone II, Capoocan, Leyte. The fire was declared out at 11:25 AM.

1. Standby Funds

09 September 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DSWD FO VIII referred the affected families to the Leyte Sub-Field Office (SFO) Team Leader for possible provision of financial assistance through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS). • DSWD FO VIII together with the LGU of Capoocan, Leyte visited the site of the incident and assessed the needs of the affected families. • DSWD FO VIII through its Disaster Response Management Division continuously monitors and coordinates with concerned offices for updates and augmentation requests.
