2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 89,892 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 54,063 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 35,829 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 13,840 FFPs available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.
- ₱207.65 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CALABARZON warehouses.
