

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. Mongol, Mayoyao, Ifugao as of 04 September 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 August 2022, a landslide incident occurred in Sitio Natulan, Barangay Mongol, Mayoyao, Ifugao due to heavy rains brought by the Southwest Monsoon.
