2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 61,216 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 35,387 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 25,829 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 17,600 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱213.58 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
