I. Situation Overview

On 5 September 2022 at around 9:58 AM, a fire incident occurred in Sitio Pajo, Brgy. Baesa, Quezon City. It was declared fire out at 12:43 PM. The cause of fire is under investigation.

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 80,242 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 41,313 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 38,929 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 18,907 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
