I. Situation Overview

On 09 September 2022 at around 2 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 8, Brgy. Nursery, Masbate City. The cause of fire is still under investigation.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱517.03 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO V.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 92,633 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 51,104 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 41,529 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

b. Food and Non-Food Items (FNIs)

09 September 2022	 DSWD FO V provided 96 FFPs, 48 sets of hygiene kits, family kits, sleeping kits and kitchen kits, and four (4) rolls and 20m laminated sacks. The City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of LGU of Masbate provided 5kg rice and ₱5,000.00 cash assistance to each affected family.

c. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
09 September 2022	 DSWD FO V facilitated the provision of cash assistance through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS). DSWD FO V continuously coordinates with the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) and CSWDO of LGU of Masbate City for the status of the affected families and any request for relief augmentation.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO V for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
