I. Situation Overview

On 07 September 2022 at around 4:58 PM, a fire incident occurred at Nickel St. cor. Dagonoy St., Brgy. 773, Manila City. The fire was declared out at 7:30 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) NCR

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **81 families** or **300 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 773, Manila City** (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱517.03 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 86,039 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 44,210 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 41,829 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 18,907 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱109.2 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
