

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Villamonte, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

as of 20 September 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 31 August 2022 at around 12NN, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Villamonte, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The Bacolod City Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) declared fire out at around 1:15 PM.
