

## DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Banuar, Laoac, Pangasinan

### I. Situation Overview

On 17 August 2022 at around 2 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Banuar, Laoac, Pangasinan. The cause of fire is due to unattended fire stove.

17 August 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>DSWD FO I through the DRMD coordinated with the MSWDO of the LGU of Laoac, Pangasinan for the validated data on affected and displaced population, damaged houses, and assistance provided.</li> </ul>
