

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incidents in Mandaue City, Cebu

12 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 September 2022 at around 12:17 AM, a fire incident occurred at Alinsug St., Brgy. Jagobiao, Mandaue City. Another fire incident in the same city transpired at M.L. Quezon St., Brgy. Casuntingan at around 3:07 AM. The fires were declared out at 12:58 AM and 3:38 AM, respectively.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **36 families** or **132 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **35 families** or **128 persons** displaced in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **36 families** or **132 persons** displaced in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **three (3) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱545,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱360,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱185,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
