I. Situation Overview

A total of **53 families** or **196 persons** are affected in **two (2) Barangays** in Libon, Albay (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱372.57 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO V.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 76,360 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 45,031 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 31,229 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 34,483 FFPs available at DSWD FO V.
- ₱214.65 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO V warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)
