

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Alegria, San Francisco, Agusan del Sur as of 27 October 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 October 2022 at around 7:40 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1 Barangay Alegria, San Francisco, Agusan del Sur. It was declared fire out at 9:15 AM. Based on the initial investigation, the cause of fire is due to faulty electrical wiring.
