

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Balabag, Malay, Aklan

17 October 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 13 October 2022 at around 3:08 PM, a fire incident occurred in Zone 4, Brgy. Balabag, Boracay Island, Malay, Aklan. The fire was declared out at 3:47 PM.

A total of **23 families** or **34 persons** are affected in **Zone 4, Brgy. Balabag, Boracay Island, Malay, Aklan** (see Table 1).
