
#### 1. Standby Funds

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 78,662 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 48,633 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 30,029 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 24,221 FFPs available at DSWD FO X.
- ₱211.91 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD FO X warehouses.
