

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Social Disorganization in Pikit, North Cotabato

as of 06 October 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 October 2022 at around 6PM, a social disorganization incident involving civilians and an undisclosed armed rebel group transpired in Pikit, North Cotabato.
