

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Balabag, Malay, Aklan

I. Situation Overview

On 13 October 2022 at around 3:08 PM, a fire incident occurred in Zone 4, Brgy. Balabag, Malay, Aklan. The ground commander of the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) Malay, Aklan declared the fire out at 3:47 PM.
