

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sto. Niño Norte, Arevalo, Iloilo City as of 19 October 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 11 October 2022 at around 7:14 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 5, Brgy. Sto. Niño Norte, Arevalo, Iloilo City. It was declared fire out at 7:38 PM.

- ₱238.35 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.

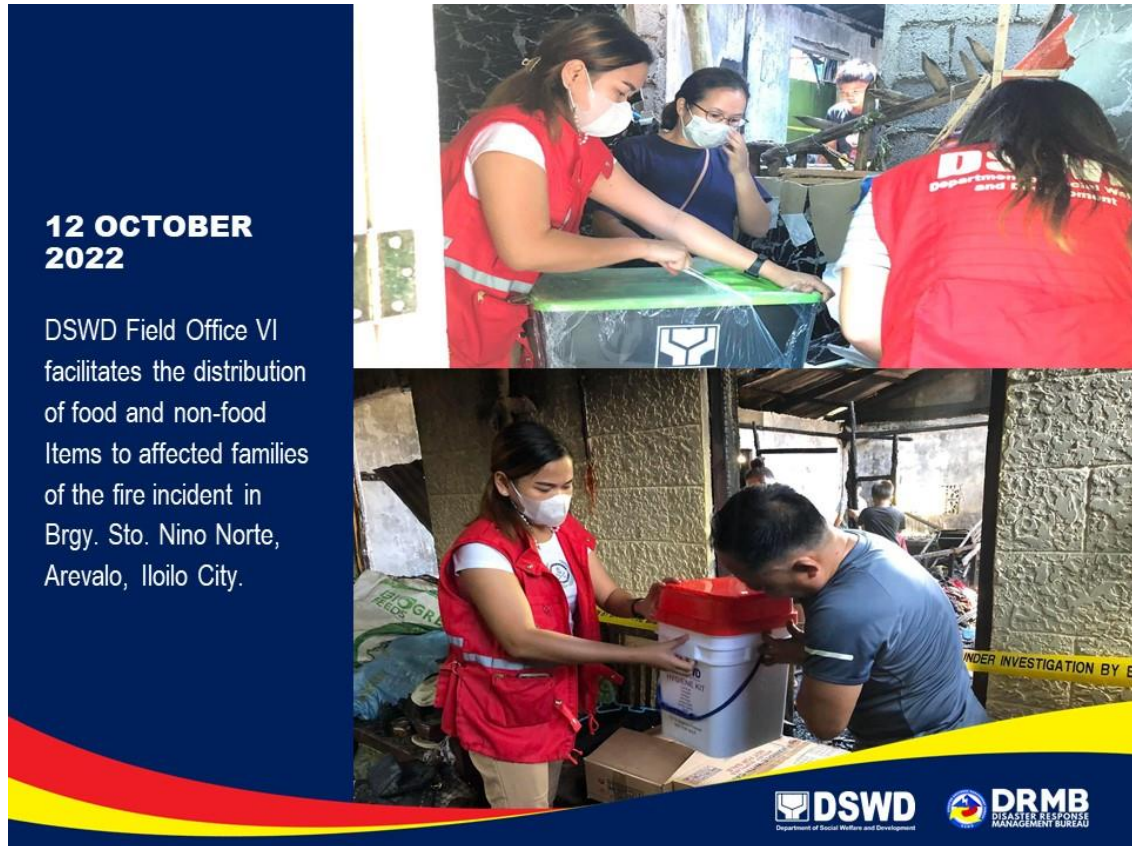
