1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 51,531 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 20,302 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 31,229 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 34,657 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱238.35 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

13 October 2022	 DSWD FO VI through the Disaster Response Management Division-Disaster Rehabilitation and Recovery Service (DRMD-DRRS) and the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of Iloilo City facilitated the distribution of FFPs, hygiene kits, sleeping kits, and family kits to the affected families. The LGU of Iloilo City provided relief assistance composed of rice and canned goods to the affected families.

17 October 2022	 DSWD FO VI through the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) continuously coordinates with the LGU of Iloilo City on the status of affected families and for any request of relief augmentation.
15 October 2022	• DSWD FO VI through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS) facilitated the provision of financial assistance to the affected families amounting to a total of ₱30,000.00.
