



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Landslide Incident in Ilocos Norte

as of 01 November 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 September 2022, a landslide incident occurred at Sitio Banguero, Brgy. Pancian, Pagudpud, Ilocos Norte causing road closure in the area. This also affected and isolated the Municipality of Adams for almost two (2) weeks with no electricity and signal.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 2,568 families or 7,095 persons are affected in three (3) barangays in llocos Norte (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱186.49 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5.08 million available at DSWD FO I.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 32,081 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 13,620 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 18,461 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 32,627 FFPs available at DSWD FO I.
- ₱190.36 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO I warehouses.

29 October 2022	DSWD FO I though the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) provided additional 1,320 FFPs to the affected families in Adams, Ilocos Norte.
08 October 2022	DSWD FO I though the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) provided 1,000 FFPs to the affected families from October 7 to 8, 2022.
