

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Flashflood Incident in Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental

as of 12 November 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 19 October 2022 at around 7:40 PM, a flashflood incident was experienced in several barangays in Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **166 families** or **805 persons** sought temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Table 2).
