

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Social Disorganization in Pikit, North Cotabato

as of 11 October 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 October 2022 at around 6PM, a social disorganization incident involving civilians and an unidentified armed rebel group transpired in Pikit, North Cotabato.

A total of **1,108 families** or **5,540 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Pikit, North Cotabato** (see Table 1).
