

## DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Social Disorganization in Pikit, North Cotabato

as of 14 October 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 05 October 2022 at around 6PM, a social disorganization incident involving civilians and an unidentified armed rebel group transpired in Pikit, North Cotabato.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,347 families** or **11,735 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Pikit, North Cotabato** (see Table 1).

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **614 families** or **3,070 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Pikit, North Cotabato** (see Table 2).
